Starting in ninth grade, you can keep a portfolio of your course grades, sports achievements and participation in clubs and community service. The value of the scholarship is \$20,000 and is renewable for up to four years for first-year students. In mid-December, the Goodnight Scholars Program will issue approximately 700-800 invitations to apply to prospective first-year NC State students who have applied for fall 2019 admission. This invitation gives each student access to the Goodnight Scholars Program online application.
