

NC COLLEGE APPLICATION WEEK

Participating Colleges and Universities

Overview

NC College Application Week is a state-wide promotional week for NC high school seniors to apply and apply early to colleges and universities in North Carolina. CAW's popularity has led some colleges and universities to decide to entirely waive the application fee during this week. Not every participating college or university waives their application fee; however for those who qualify they will accept the College Board College Application Fee Waiver during CAW.

Application Fee Waivers Based on Financial Need

Waivers of admission application fees for students with a demonstrated financial need and for whom an application fee would create an undue burden are provided at all of the 36 private colleges and universities as well as all of the 16 University of North Carolina system campuses. Application fee waivers due to financial hardship are provided to ensure no student is deprived of the opportunity to pursue admission to the institution(s) of their choice.

Students who are eligible for fee waivers for the standard college entrance tests (SAT and ACT) are usually eligible for application fee waivers. Encourage students to talk with their school counselor in advance of College Application Week to discuss need and availability.

College Board – College Application Fee Waivers

College application fee waivers (CAFW) will be distributed electronically to eligible students. Because students who take the SAT using a fee waiver have already had their eligibility verified by their counselor, CAFWs do not require additional counselor approval. Eligible students will receive notification of their CAFWs and be able to access them via their College Board accounts. Students are assigned a unique fee waiver code that they can submit with four of their college applications.

For students who are eligible for a fee waiver but did not take the SAT or for students who need more than the four application fee waivers provided by the College Board, we would suggest using the NACAC fee waiver.
