- Complete tshirt size survey

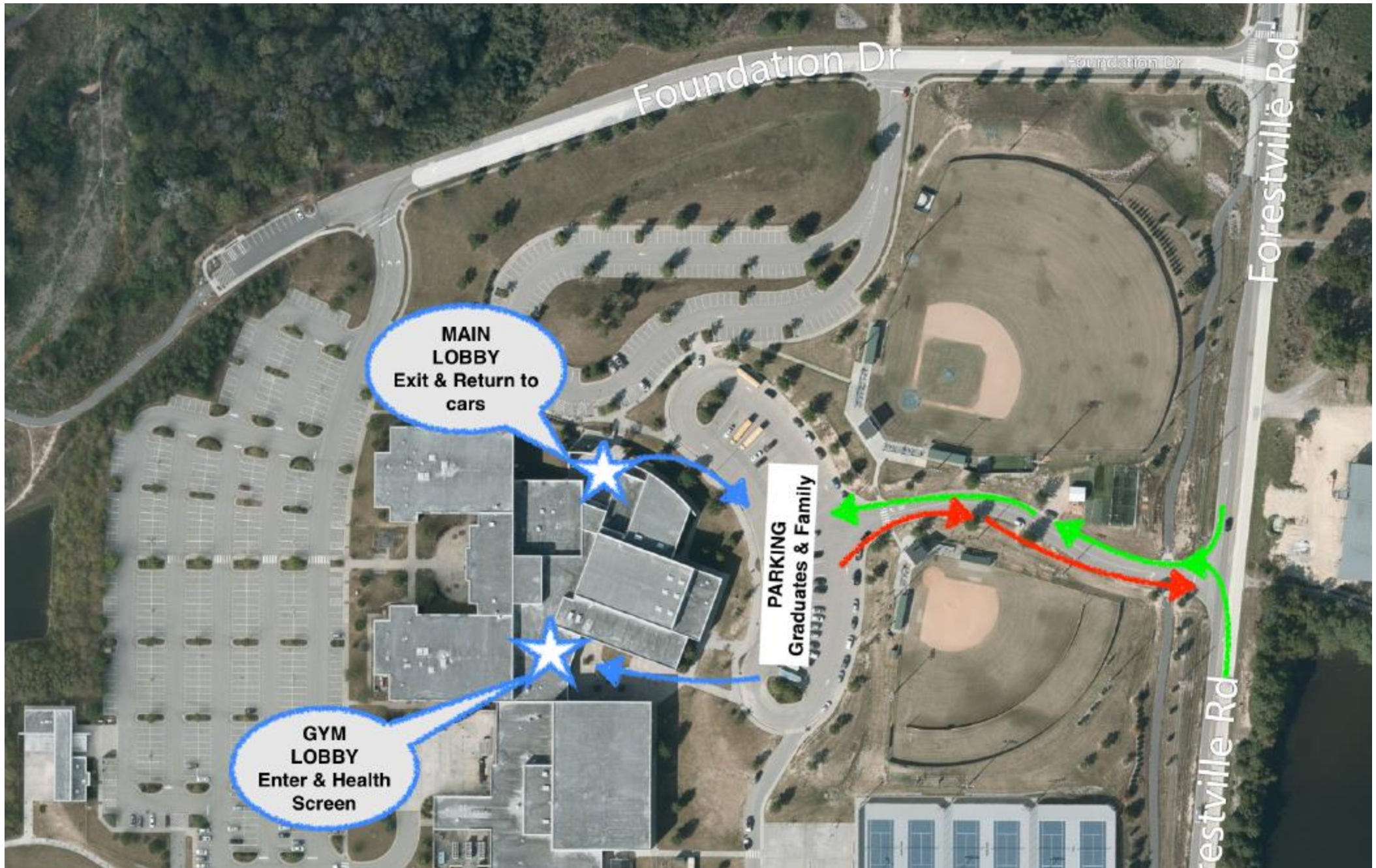
Graduation Prep

What happens during the walkthrough...

- Step 1 – Screenings
- Step 2 – Proceed to 1300 hallway to enter the auditorium
- Step 3 – Family watches from auditorium as graduate crosses the stage to receive diploma. Pause for photo and congratulatory message
- Step 4 – Exit from front of auditorium and proceed to main lobby
- Step 5 – Stop at table for gifts and photos
- Step 6 – Exit building and enjoy being a graduate!
