Attire for Senior Day?

- Casual! (school dress code still applies)
- Rep your college or Rep your military branch by wearing a shirt that represents your post high school plans
- You can also choose to just rep the Huskies that day!

Special Notes for Senior Day

- Attendance is mandatory. School day attendance. Absences WILL affect exam exemption status.
- Concerned about your graduation status? After class night rehearsal, you can choose to return to class for the remainder of the day if your time is better spent getting caught up on work to ensure earning a diploma.

Senior Class Night & Reception: Wednesday, May 22

- Graduation protocol attire required along with your cap and gown
- Report to designated location at 5:30pm
- Doors open for guests at 5:45pm
- Ceremony begins at 6:30pm
- Reception immediately follows

Cap & Gown Attire for Women

- Lightweight dress under robe not to exceed length of gown, dark shoes, minimal jewelry
- ***No tennis shoes, boots, sandals, flip flops, purses, handbags or cameras

Cap & Gown Attire for Men

- White collar dress shirt and dark solid tie, dark dress slacks, dark dress socks dark dress shoes ***No tennis shoes, boots, sandals, flip flops or cameras

- **Note for everyone:** your dress shoes should be solid color (no jewels or other designs) and not lighter than the color of your graduation gown!

The gown and extras.....

- Only honor cords/stoles issued by approved HHS organizations can be worn with cap/gown. Cords from outside organizations or those purchased online may not be worn. You may be dismissed from participation if you are found wearing unapproved cords/stoles.
- Caps and gowns may not be decorated. They must remain in their original form.
- You will be checked prior to ceremonies to ensure you are outfitted appropriately.

Whole School Awards – Thursday, May 23

- You will need your cap/gown again! You do NOT have to wear graduation protocol attire. Attire is casual dressy, but no jeans or sneakers, please.
- Report to advisory at 7:25am and prepare for lineup.
- Leave your belongings in classroom until after awards program.
- You will be seated in chairs on gym floor area, same as Wednesday's senior night. Some seniors will receive additional awards.

Pick up your graduation announcements!

- Many of you have NOT picked up your reprinted graduation announcements. The first printing has mistakes. Jostens reprinted graduation announcements for those who ordered them. Get them from Student Services before you leave TODAY!

About Graduation Rehearsal...

- Tuesday, June 4
- This is MANDATORY. **No exceptions.**
- You may NOT schedule to attend a college orientation on this day. Colleges provide many options for orientation dates. Choose another date.
- You should NOT plan any other trips/vacation on same day of rehearsal. This date was provided in August.
- **Plan on missing rehearsal? You should also plan to not participate in your graduation ceremony.**

Instructions for Getting to Rehearsal:

- All seniors will be dismissed at 2pm in order to get downtown safely.
- Want to ride the HUSKY bus? You must sign up in Student Services. Seating is limited, so first come is first served. The HUSKY bus will leave at 2pm as well.
- You are encouraged to carpool to save money on parking. Maps to downtown and parking garage locations are on the senior page of the website and hardcopies are available at Counseling Corner.

Getting cleared for graduation...

- The following MUST happen in order for you to be cleared for graduation:
- Satisfied all credit requirements
- Satisfied all course requirements
- Pay all outstanding fees and fines
- Pay senior fee
- Complete graduate intention survey

Graduation Tickets Update!

- Because seniors cannot be cleared for graduation until June 7 (exams begin after rehearsal has taken place), ticket distribution will now begin on June 7 and continue through June 11. Additional tickets secured via request will be picked up at same time. Stay tuned for more details about times to pick up tickets and how/when to request additional tickets.
