Nomination Process

1. Complete the interest form, attach your written response and resume, and return to Student Services no later than Monday, September 9 at 2:30pm.
2. Go to www.moreheadcain.org to begin your application (if not selected as a nominee, you'll be considered a direct applicant). List Ms. Williams as your counselor. The actual application is due by October 15, and you should begin completing all required parts, regardless of our nomination process.
3. Some nominee candidates will be interviewed on Thursday, September 26. Please make yourself available after school. Ms. Williams will confirm the time and location.

Note: The scholarship application must be submitted online by October 15. Whether a school nominee or direct applicant, please take note, preview the application and prepare to complete all materials by the established deadline.
